

STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

CND Shellac Removal



Proper removal of CND Shellac polish is vital to the long-term health of your natural nails. If there is a need for removal, take extra care not to damage the natural nail during the process.

STEP 1: CLEANSE HANDS

1. Wash hands with soap & water and towel dry.

STEP 2: PREPARE FILES

1. To ensure you remove the sharp edges of a new file, gently run the file edges along the edges of another file.

STEP 3: WRAP EACH NAIL

1. Tear along the line of your remover wrap sachet. Peel off and discard film.
2. Insert your finger, positioning nail in contact with the pre-soaked pad.
3. Fold over sides of sachet to meet sticky side. Wait 8 minutes (15 minutes for CND Shellac Duraforce Top Coat).

STEP 4: REMOVE SHELLAC

1. Twist off sachet wrap one nail at a time. Discard wrap and gently remove the soft product with an orangewood stick.

STEP 5: SHAPE & RE-HYDRATE

1. Wash hands with soap and warm water.
2. Use the black 240 grit file to shape the natural nail.
2. Replenish and condition the nails and skin with CND™ SOLAROIL™ and CND Scentsations lotion.





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CND Brisa Gel Nail Enhancements Removal

Proper removal of gel enhancements is vital to the long-term health of your natural nails. BRISA™ Gel Enhancements are permanent enhancements and are not designed to be removed regularly. If there is a need for removal, take extra care not to damage the natural nail during the process.

STEP 1: CLEANSE HANDS

1. Wash hands with soap & water and towel dry.



STEP 2: PREPARE FILES

1. To ensure you remove the sharp edges of a new file, gently run the file edges along the edges of another file.

STEP 3: REDUCE THE ENHANCEMENT

1. To safely remove BRISA™ Gel, reduce the entire enhancement with a 100/180 grit File including length, leaving a very thin layer of product. Use caution and a soft touch, being careful not to file all the way to the natural nail.



STEP 4: APPLY COTTON & FOIL

1. Apply cotton that has been saturated in OFFLY FAST™ Moisturising Remover to each nail and wrap entire fingertip with foil. This will allow the product to warm to body temperature and speed up the removal process.

2. Allow 40 to 60 minutes for the OFFLY FAST™ to “swell” the molecular chains in the enhancement making the coating soft (like rubber). This process helps loosen the bond between the coating and the natural nail.



STEP 5: REMOVE COTTON & FOIL

1. Remove the foil from the nails. Remove the soft product with an orangewood stick and use the purple 240 grit file to buff the rest of the enhancement off; taking care not to file the natural nail.
2. Use black 240 grit file to shape the natural nail.
3. Wash hands and condition the nails and skin with CND™ SOLAROIL™.





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CND Liquid & Powder Nail Enhancements Removal

Proper removal of enhancements is vital to the long-term health of your natural nails. Enhancements do not need to be removed periodically for the health of the nail. However, should you wish, Liquid & Powder Enhancements can be removed safely. If there is a need for removal, take extra care not to damage the natural nail during the process.

STEP 1: CLEANSE HANDS

1. Wash hands with soap & water and towel dry.



STEP 2: PREPARE FILES

1. To ensure you remove the sharp edges of a new file, gently run the file edges along the edges of another file.

STEP 3: REDUCE THE ENHANCEMENT

1. To safely remove, reduce the entire enhancement with a 100/180 grit file including length, leaving a very thin layer of product. Use caution and a soft touch, being careful not to file all the way to the natural nail.



STEP 4: APPLY COTTON & FOIL

1. Apply cotton that has been saturated in OFFLY FAST™ Moisturising Remover to each nail and wrap entire fingertip with foil. This will allow the product to warm to body temperature and speed up the removal process.

2. Allow 30 to 40 minutes for the OFFLY FAST™ to “swell” the molecular chains in the enhancement making the coating soft (like rubber). This process helps loosen the bond between the coating and the natural nail.



STEP 5: REMOVE COTTON & FOIL

1. Remove the foil from the nails. Remove the soft product with an orangewood stick and use the purple 240 grit file to buff the rest of the enhancement off; taking care not to file the natural nail.
2. Use black 240 grit file to shape the natural nail.
3. Wash hands and condition the nails and skin with CND™ SOLAROIL™.
